FOLLOW UP QUESTIONS:

- Aiming for urgencies: What prevents believers from thinking of the Holy Spirit as a person, and how does this impact one's ability to be loved and to love the Holy Spirit, as our friend, guest and interior Master (cf. CCC 1697)? What is lost when the charisms of the Holy Spirit (faith, healing, miracles, wisdom, knowledge, discernment of spirits, prophecy, tongues, interpretation) are overlooked and/or dismissed altogether?
- 2. What are the *top two or three practical take-aways* from this webinar to help you become more aware of the personal action of the Holy Spirit through his traditional gifts and the charismatic gifts (cf. 1 Cor 12-14)?
- 3. One theme you may have heard during this webinar is that the Holy Spirit has poured out His gifts, both for you and for others; and yet, we need to open these gifts in order for them to be fully received. What are one or two ways you open these gifts, and allow the Holy Spirit to work?
- 4. *Questions to think about*: Are the charisms of the Holy Spirit only for the early Church? Is there a special need for the charisms today, which appears to be a "new apostolic age"? How can we foster a docility to the Holy Spirit, in the face of our radicalized freedom?
